Culture plays a prominent role in shaping a person's beliefs and ideologies. Culture refers to the various sets of beliefs, values, behaviors and the ways of life of a particular community. It influences how people think, communicate and live with each other. Culture is a tool that connects the individuals within a community. It provides people with a sense of identity, belonging and purpose. The culture is responsible in the preservation and transfer of traditional values and rituals of a particular community. Recognizing the importance of culture the college has adopted the **Promotion of Culture and Traditional Value** as one of its best practices. For this purpose a Cultural Fiesta was organized by the IQAC on 19th March, 2025 in the college.

Major Attractions:

- **Traditional Attires:** One of the captivating highlights of the Fiesta was the vibrant display of Traditional attires by the students. The girls as well as the boys adorned themselves in traditional attires reflecting the rich cultural heritage of the Nankhari region. The attire was complete with traditional jewelry including Bragar, aamli, Trimani and other accessories that added to the uniqueness of Pahari culture. The girls were garbed in "Peticcoat/ Rejta" (a long ankle length under skirt worn beneath the long shirt), paired with a "sadri"(a sleeveless waistcoat) and a "Dhattu" (a traditional headscarf or piece of cloth worn over the head by the women), symbolizing the modesty and cultural identity. The boys wore the traditional kurtas paired with a sadri and a Pahari Topi.
- **Food Festival:** In addition to the exceptional showcasing of the culture through the traditional attires the fiesta also brought into the spotlight the food culture of the region. The students brought traditional home made dishes illuminating on the taste of the

traditional cuisine. The major attractions of the food festival were traditional siddus with ghee, pakkain, loutte etc. The beautiful presentation of the dishes and the warm hospitality at the stalls created a festive atmosphere, offering a culinary experience to all visitors.

- **Pahari Boli:** A unique and heartwarming feature of the fiesta was the encouragement of students to converse in their local dialects during the event. This initiative added an authentic touch to the celebrations and allowed everyone to experience the richness and nuances of the regional language.

Objectives: The major objectives of the Cultural Fiesta are as follows:

- **Promotion of Cultural Awareness**
- **Interest towards local cuisine**
- **Promotion of linguistic pride**
- **Preservation of regional identity**

The Cultural Fiesta 2024 was a resounding success, leaving everyone with memorable experiences.
