

# Report on World Consumer Rights Day - 2025 Celebration

The Department of Economics and Commerce organized a comprehensive and engaging event to celebrate World Consumer Rights Day 2025 on March 15th, 2025. ## Inaugural Lecture on Consumer Rights:

The event began with an insightful and thought-provoking lecture delivered by Prof. Dev Kumar Negi. Prof. Negi commenced his lecture by explaining the Consumer Protection Act of 1986, focusing on the key provisions designed to safeguard the rights of consumers and ensure fair trade practices. He provided an in-depth analysis of the Act's historical context, highlighting its significance in the Indian legal framework.

Prof. Negi also discussed the Consumer Protection Act of 2019, which replaced the 1986 Act to address the evolving challenges faced by consumers in the digital age. He explained the major updates in the 2019 Act, such as the introduction of e-commerce regulations, the establishment of the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA), and the introduction of alternative dispute resolution mechanisms. The lecture was highly informative, giving students a deeper understanding of the legal tools available to protect consumer interests.

## Video Screening on Consumer Rights

After the lecture, the program continued with the screening of a video on consumer rights, which was made available on YouTube. The video highlighted real-world scenarios where consumer rights were violated and demonstrated the importance of being informed and vigilant about one's rights as a consumer. The video served as an excellent visual complement to the lecture, reinforcing the key messages discussed and engaging students through practical examples of consumer-related issues.

## Essay Writing Competition

To further encourage critical thinking and creative expression, an essay writing competition was organized for the students. The theme of the competition centered around "The Importance of Consumer Protection in Today's World". Students were tasked with writing essays that explored the various dimensions of consumer rights, including legal, ethical, and social aspects, as well as the role of individuals, businesses, and government agencies in ensuring consumer welfare.
