Key Highlights of the Session:

- **Role of Police During Accidents:**

Shri Vinod Ji explained the step-by-step duties of police officials in the event of a road accident, including securing the accident site, assisting victims, recording witness accounts, and coordinating with medical services.

- **FIR and Legal Procedures:**

The speaker elaborated on the importance of filing an FIR, the rights of complainants, and how the FIR plays a crucial role in investigations and legal proceedings.

- **Vehicle Insurance and Claim Process:**

Students were guided through the basic procedure for filing insurance claims after an accident, the importance of timely reporting, and the required documentation.

- **Traffic Rules and Violations:**

Emphasis was placed on following traffic norms, wearing helmets and seatbelts, and the penalties associated with common infractions like over speeding, drunk driving, and underage driving.

- **Road Fatalities and Data:**

Shri Vinod Ji shared alarming statistics about road accidents in India, noting that the country has one of the highest road-related fatalities globally. This led to a discussion on preventive measures and the urgent need for awareness.

- **Dangers of Rash and Intoxicated Driving:**

The session concluded with a strong message against reckless and drunk driving, citing real-life examples to illustrate the tragic outcomes of such behaviour.

Key Takeaways:

- A clear understanding of police duties and public cooperation during emergencies.
- Familiarity with legal processes like FIR filing and insurance claims.
- Increased awareness of traffic rules and consequences of violations.
- Realization of the severe impact of rash and intoxicated driving.
- Motivation to become more responsible road users and informed citizens.

Feedback:

- Students described the session as eye-opening and appreciated the opportunity to interact directly with a law enforcement officer.
- Many expressed that the lecture helped them overcome hesitation in approaching the police or getting involved in emergency situations.
- Faculty members noted that the session had a practical and relatable approach, making legal concepts accessible and engaging.
- Several students requested more such interactions to stay informed about their rights and duties as citizens.
