

Road Safety Oath and Awareness Quiz

1. Introduction

The Road Safety Cell of Government College, Nankhari organised a *Road Safety Awareness Oath Ceremony* and a *Quiz Competition* on 31st October 2025 to promote awareness regarding safe driving practices and road discipline among students. The event was coordinated by Dr. Punita Verma, Coordinator of the Road Safety Cell.

2. Welcome Address

The program began with a welcome address by Dr. Punita Verma, who highlighted the growing concern over road accidents and emphasized the importance of traffic discipline, responsible driving, and civic sense. She motivated students to play a proactive role in promoting road safety awareness among their peers and communities.

3. Road Safety Oath Ceremony

The Road Safety Oath was administered by Ms. Kamlesh, Student Representative of the Road Safety Club and a student of *B.A. 3rd Year*. All students, faculty members, and participants present took the oath with sincerity and determination. The oath included pledges such as:

- Always wearing helmets or seat belts while driving.
- Avoiding over-speeding and driving under the influence.
- Helping accident victims as responsible citizens and *Good Samaritans*.

The oath ceremony served as a reminder of each individual's responsibility towards road safety and accident prevention.

4. Road Safety Awareness Quiz Competition

Following the oath ceremony, a Road Safety Awareness Quiz Competition was conducted to assess students' knowledge of road safety norms and traffic laws. The quiz comprised 50 questions, each carrying 5 marks, to be answered within 10 seconds. In case of no or incorrect response, the question was passed to the audience, followed by an explanation of the correct answer.

5. Topics Covered in the Quiz

The quiz included questions from the following areas:

- Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and its amendments
- Road safety rules and traffic signs
- Pedestrian safety

- Vehicle-related documents (Driving License, Registration Certificate, Insurance, Pollution Certificate, etc.)
- Vehicle maintenance and roadworthiness
- Procedure for obtaining a driving license
- Traffic violations and penalties
- First aid, golden hour, CPR, and Good Samaritan law
- FIR and its legal significance

6. Conduct of the Quiz

The quiz was conducted jointly by Prof. Punita Verma and Prof. Lalit Kumar, with Prof. Dev serving as the *timekeeper* and Prof. Sharmila as the *scorekeeper*.

Participating Teams:

- Team A: Rajat (B.A. 3rd Year) and Shivana (B.A. 1st Year)
- Team B: Udyat (B.A. 2nd Year) and Nitish (B.A. 1st Year)
- Team C: Sahil (B.A. 1st Year) and Aman (B.A. 1st Year)

After a keenly contested session, Team C emerged as the *winner*, while Team A secured the *second position*.

7. Feedback

The overall response to the event was highly positive. Participants and audience members appreciated the interactive and informative nature of the quiz. Students shared that they gained valuable insights into real-life applications of road safety rules and laws. Teachers praised the efforts of the Road Safety Cell for organising such a meaningful event that blended learning with awareness. Many students expressed interest in more such activities, including mock traffic sessions, poster-making competitions, and workshops on first aid and accident response.

8. Conclusion and Vote of Thanks

The program concluded with a Vote of Thanks delivered by Dr. Punita Verma, who expressed gratitude to all faculty members, student participants, and volunteers for their active cooperation and enthusiasm. She commended the spirit of teamwork and encouraged the youth to practice and promote road safety in their daily lives.

The Road Safety Oath Ceremony and Quiz Competition proved to be both educational and motivational.


The event helped:
