

## **Road Safety Awareness Through Rangoli Art**

### **Introduction**

The college's Road Safety Club organised a Rangoli Activity on 30 November 2025 to promote *Road Safety Awareness* among students. The event aimed to creatively communicate the importance of road signs, traffic rules, and safe driving habits. By integrating art with awareness, the activity encouraged students to reflect on their responsibility as citizens and future drivers.

### **Main Event**

Students participated enthusiastically, forming 4 groups in total. Each group designed a vibrant and meaningful rangoli centred on the theme of road safety. The colourful artworks highlighted key messages such as adherence to traffic signs, avoiding overspeeding, the importance of wearing helmets and seatbelts, and general safe road behaviour. After completing their rangolis, participants explained the ideas behind their designs, educating fellow students on the significance of their chosen symbols and messages.

Group 2 was declared the winner for their well-conceptualised design and clear communication of safety messages through their rangoli art.


### **Outcome**


### **Feedback**
