Opening Remarks and NSP Overview:

Speaker: Prof. Dev Kumar Negi, Convenor of the Scholarship Committee

Content: Prof. Negi provided an in-depth overview of the National Scholarship Portal (NSP), highlighting its new developments and updates. He emphasized the introduction of NSPOTR (One Time Registration) which is now mandatory for students applying for scholarships via NSP.

Instructions: Students were guided to download two essential apps from the Google Play Store: NSPOTR and AdhaarFACERD. These apps are necessary to complete the One Time Registration (OTR) process.

Detailed Explanation of Scholarship Schemes:

Speaker: Prof. Punita Verma, Co-Convener of the Scholarship Committee

Content: Prof. Verma detailed the various scholarship schemes available on NSP. She particularly focused on the following schemes which offer significant benefits to a broad range of students:

1. **Centrally Sponsored Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC Students (H.P.):** A scheme aimed at providing financial support for students from Scheduled Castes pursuing post-matriculation education.
2. **Kalpana Chawla Chhatravriti Yojna:** A scholarship scheme designed to support students excelling in their academic endeavours.
3. **IRDP/BPL Scholarship Scheme (Renamed as “Mukhya Mantri Vidyarthi Kalyan Yojna”):** This scheme, formerly known as IRDP/BPL, is now rebranded to offer financial aid to students from Below Poverty Line (BPL) families.
4. **Dr. Ambedkar Medhavi Chhatravriti Yojna:** A scholarship program for meritorious SC students named in honour of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar.
