- **Key Skills Required:** Communication, numerical aptitude, customer service orientation, and decision-making ability.
- **Preparation Tips:** Effective strategies, time management, reliable study resources, and mock test importance.
- **Growth and Promotion:** Career progression opportunities within the banking sector and how employees can advance through internal exams and performance-based promotions.

The session concluded with an open interaction, during which students raised queries regarding exam patterns, interview challenges, and job expectations, which the speakers answered comprehensively.
